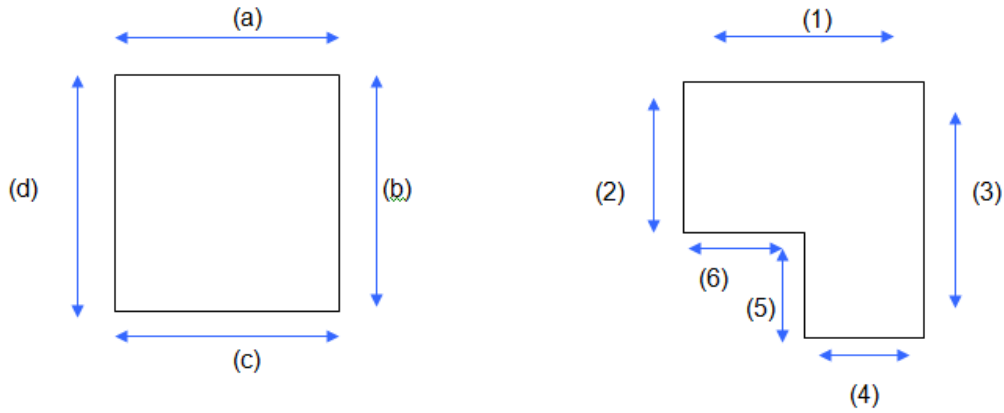

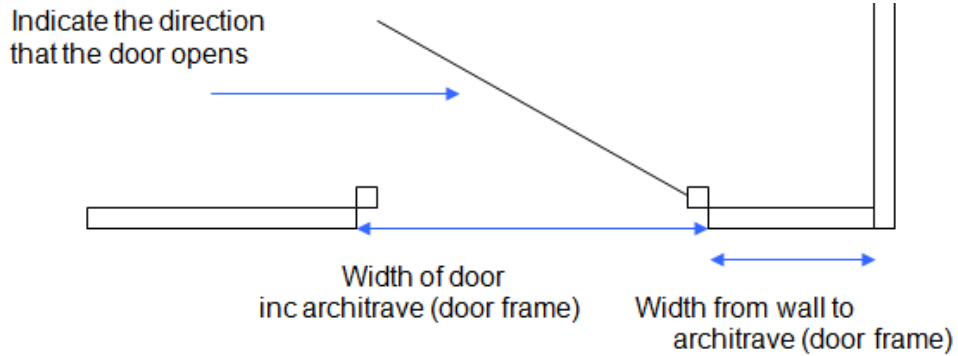
Start by measuring the total space of your room



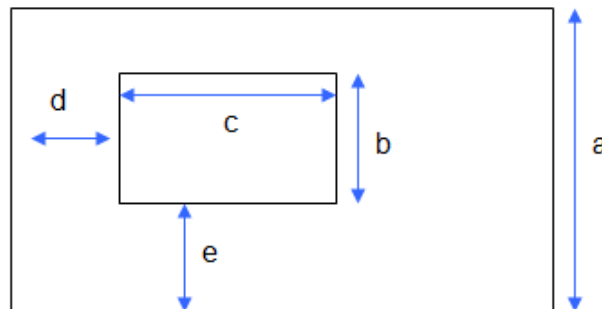
A + C Should equal the same

3 Should equal the same as 5 + 2

WINDOWS - please mark which wall and where the window is positioned on the plan

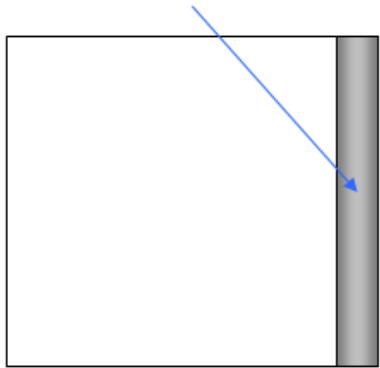


- (a) Height from floor to ceiling

- (e) Height from floor to window sill

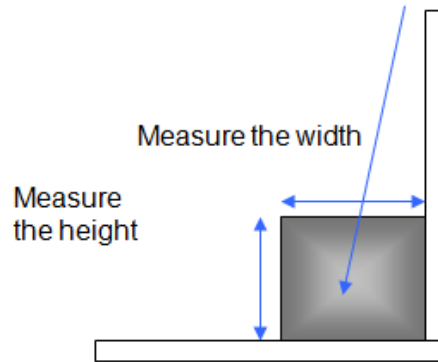


BOXINGS—show any floor to ceiling and low level boxing

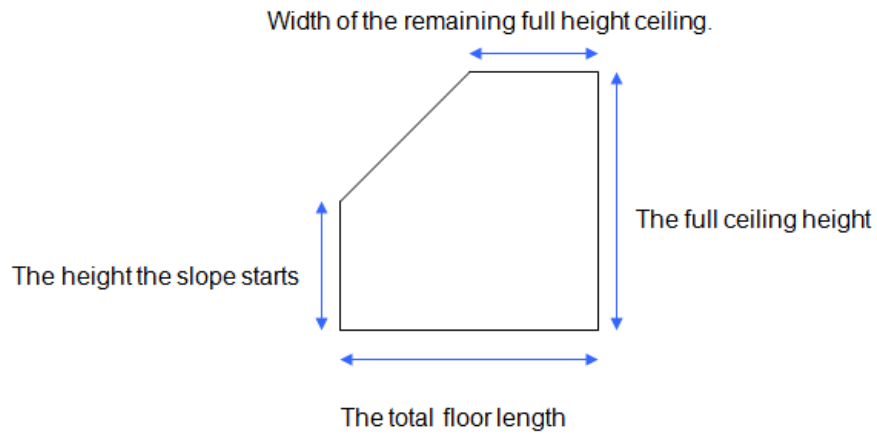

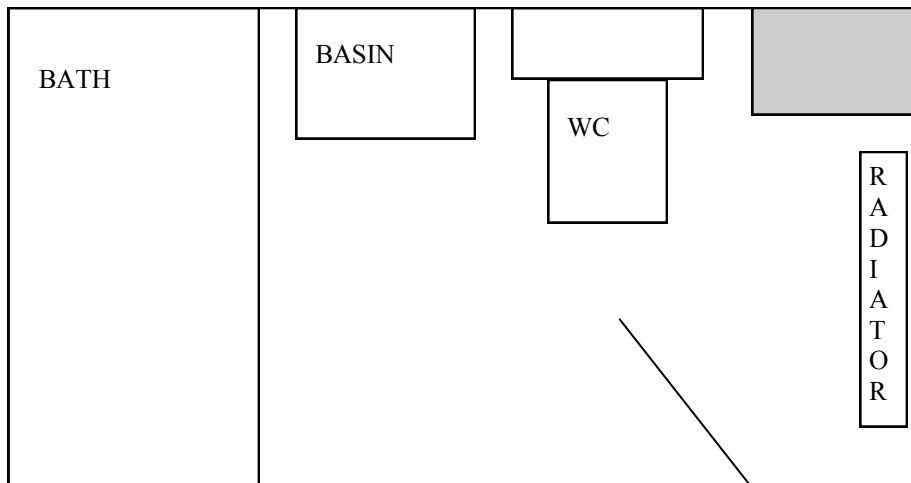
Cross section showing boxing:
